<p>In COD System Message Classes Used by EDExpress section:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Removed the CRSU24OP message class associated with the Subsidized Usage System-Generated Response, which is no longer generated by the COD System. • Removed references to the now-discontinued DL Tools software from Data Type text associated with the Direct Loan School Account Statement and Rebuild File, which can now be imported into EDExpress. 	82-84

<p>Updated the Pell Grant External Origination Add/Change (PGEO24OP) record layout as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Updated Processing Notes/Edits column for Ability to Benefit Completion Date (field #14) and Ability to Benefit State Code (field #17) to indicate the fields are now required if the Student Eligibility Code is 03 (State Process). All three fields are part of the student demographic record in EDExpress. • Increased the field length for Cost of Attendance (field #28) to eight bytes and revised the valid value range to 00000000-99999999. As a result of this length increase, we removed the one-byte filler field that was previously field #29 and renumbered subsequent fields accordingly. The total file byte size remains at 400 bytes. 	90, 92
Updated the Pell Grant External Abbreviated Disbursement Data (PGAD24OP) record layout to revise the valid field content for Disbursement Number to indicate value must be a numeric value between 01-20.	107
<p>Updated the Direct Loan External Import Origination Add (DIEA24OP) record layout as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Added notes to valid field content for Ability to Benefit Completion Date (field #23) and Ability to Benefit State Code (field #25) indicating the fields are now required if the Student Eligibility Code is 03 (State Process). All three fields are part of the student demographic record in EDExpress. • Increased the field length for Loan Amount Approved (field #34) to six bytes. To accommodate this change, we decreased the field length of the filler field (#33) preceding Loan Amount Approved in the layout to three bytes. 	114, 116

Increased the field length for Actual Disbursement Net Adjustment Amount to seven bytes. External Loan Reconciliation (DLEXLOAN) – Enables the import of loan detail data from an external source. Previously referenced as the Loan Detail External Add import in DL Tools. DLEXDISB – Enables the import of disbursement detail data from an external source. Previously referenced as the Disbursement Detail External Add import in DL Tools. 	209-212
