How to Use the Tables

The information in this section is provided for you to use as a quick reference. The <u>Federal Student Aid</u> <u>Handbook</u>, Volume 1–Student Eligibility contains detailed information about student eligibility and the action needed to resolve discrepancies found in the data matches. The handbook can be found in the Knowledge Center.

A flag of **C** is an indicator that institutional resolution is required. The former CPS C Flag is now called the FPS C Flag and serves the same purpose. The FPS C Flag is printed on the FAFSA Submission Summary next to the Student Aid Index (SAI) if any of the conditions described in the tables are met.

The following comments will have the FPS C Flag set:

018 to 020, 040, 076, 096, 127, 155, 158 to 160, 162 to 165, 216, 217, 221 to 253, 255, 256, 258, 260, 261, 264, 265, 276, 277, 288, 289, 293, 294, 303, 325, and 326.

Note: Some of these data match results generate rejected records. Comments associated with a match-results reject do not generate the FPS C Flag. However, an FPS C Flag could be generated by another match-result comment and is printed on a FAFSA Submission Summary rejected for other than match-results reasons.

The SAI is not provided on any rejected records except for when a student has unusual circumstance, then a Provisional SAI is calculated. The FAA must confirm the student's unusual circumstance situation, obtain the necessary documentation, and if valid, perform a professional judgement. This will suppress the reject and an official SAI will be calculated for the student. If the unusual circumstance is not valid for a professional judgement, the student must provide parental information in order for an SAI to be calculated and the reject removed.

Department of Homeland Security (DHS) Primary Match

Identifying information is sent to DHS for eligible noncitizen matching when an applicant provides an A-Number on the FAFSA form.

Department of Homeland Security Secondary Match

When a record fails the DHS Primary Match, FPS holds the record for up to three processing days to receive results from the DHS secondary match.

After three days, if DHS does not return a response, FPS generates an *Institutional Student Information Record* (ISIR), which shows the student's eligible noncitizen status as "P" or pending in the DHS Secondary Match Status field. Once a response is available, a system-generated transaction will be created indicating one of the other codes in the following table.
