Don't wait to complete your form if you plan to attend college, career school, or trade school between July 1, 2025, and June 30, 2026. Submitting a FAFSA form today is the best way to be eligible for as much aid as possible.

Remember: You must submit a FAFSA form every year you're in school to stay eligible for federal student aid.

If you're a [dependent student](#), we recommend that you start your FAFSA form and complete your sections first to save time and prevent errors. When you fill out the FAFSA form, you'll answer questions that will determine if you'll need to invite anyone else (such as a parent) to participate on your form.
