Sample *Master Promissory Notes*

Some schools may be interested in sample *Master Promissory Notes* (MPNs). Below we provide those sample documents. Schools that use only paper MPNs may also:

- Print a blank MPN from the [Common Origination and Disbursement \(COD\) website's](#) Services page.
- Direct the borrower to print a blank MPN from the StudentAid.gov website.
- Produce or program the entire form. Schools that create their own MPN must submit a copy of the school-produced version to Federal Student Aid for testing to ensure that it can be processed.
