Additions to COD for 2021-2022

Modifications to COD for 2021-2022

Edits 039, 172 and 173

The COD System has been updated to allow the Pell Grant Award Amount to exceed the Scheduled Award Amount when a disbursement

has been flagged with the Coronavirus Disaster Relief (or other Disaster Relief LEU Adjustment) at your school for that award year so the student may utilize their regained eligibility in the same award year if needed.

Edit logic for correcting/rejecting Edits 039, 172 and 173 have been updated to account for this new award amount limit. Please see Volume 2, Section 4 for more details.

Edit 165

With TEACH Regulatory changes, references to ATS will be replaced with Agreement. The edit text for rejecting Edit 165 will be updated from “No ATS on File” to “No Agreement on File”. Please see Volume 2, Section 4 for more details.

SULA Repeal

Beginning in July 2021, the COD system will not apply the 150% Subsidized Usage limit for Direct Subsidized Loans or Direct Unsubsidized Loans with an Earliest Disbursement Date (EDD) on or after 07/01/2021. The updates will also be reflected in the Subsidized Usage Calculator that is currently available on the COD Web site.

Additionally, this COD update impacts Edits 206 and 207. For further details regarding edit processing for these edits, see Volume 2, Section 4 for more details.

Edits 206

The rejecting Edit 206 will be updated to only trigger for Award Year 2014-2015 and forward Direct Subsidized Loans with an Earliest Disbursement Date before 07/01/2021.

Edits 207

The rejecting Edit 207 will be updated to only trigger for Award Year 2014-2015 and forward for Direct Subsidized Loan with an Earliest Disbursement Date before 07/01/2021.

Removals from COD for 2021-2022

Edit 225

Rejecting Edit 225 that would trigger to reject an actual disbursement submitted with no Informed Borrowing completed on file will not be applicable for 2021-2022.
