Along with the updated software posted on the [Software and Other Tools](#) page of the Knowledge Center website, initialization files are available for the SAIG Mainframe/Midrange TDClient installation as well as the SAIG Host Communication Guide.

Both the TDClient 3.3.1 and 3.4 versions include the following enhancements:

- TDClient has been enhanced to support TLS 1.2 security standards.
- TDClient Linux 64-bit (version 3.4.0 only) has been updated to include added support for newer CPU technology.

All SAIG TDClient users must download and install an updated version of the TDClient application in order to comply with federal mandate [Binding Operational Directive \(BOD\) 18-01](#), to improve email and web security. Core functionality of the product remains unchanged and users should expect no impact to existing workflows.
