This letter provides information that supplements the 2019–2020 award year

verification information provided in the Federal Register notice published on

March 28, 2018.

Dear Colleague:

On March 28, 2018, we published a Federal Register notice (Vol. 83, No. 60 p. 13266–13269) announcing the 2019–2020 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) items that may require verification for an applicant selected for verification by the Department, as well as the acceptable documentation for those items. The 2019–2020 FAFSA items that may require verification and the 2019-2020 Verification Tracking Groups are the same as those for the 2018–2019 award year. Also, there were no changes to the acceptable documentation requirement for 2019–2020, as specified in the Federal Register notice.

Departmental Verification Selection

As in prior years, the Department will use data-based statistical analysis to select for verification the 2019–2020 FAFSA applicants with the highest statistical probability of error and the greatest impact of such error on award amounts. The Central Processing System (CPS) will set a Verification Tracking Flag on a selected applicant's *Institutional Student Information Record* (ISIR) indicating that the applicant was selected by the Department for institutional verification. The ISIR will also indicate the Verification Tracking Group for the applicant. See below for a listing of the 2019–2020 Verification Tracking Groups.

Suggested Verification Text

In a subsequent posting on the <u>Information for Financial Aid Professionals (IFAP) website</u>, we will provide suggested verification text for the 2019–2020 FAFSA items.

The individual FAFSA items from the 2019–2020 *Federal Register* notice that an applicant must verify are based upon the Verification Tracking Group to which the applicant is assigned as outlined in the following chart.
