What is the EDE Technical Reference?

■ What is it?

- Reference tool explaining the electronic data exchange (EDE) process with the Central Processing System (CPS)
- Map describing what to expect in each position of a file or a long string of alpha and numeric characters



What is the EDE Tech Ref? (Cont.)

■ Who is it used by?

- Schools in the programming area or financial aid office
- State agencies
- Third Party Servicers
- CPS
 - Customer service
 - Development departments

- Overview, section 1
 - Explains the different EDE processes
 - What's New and What's Changed for 2001-2002
 - Sources of Assistance- lists phone numbers and email addresses



Structure of EDE Tech Ref (Cont.)

- EDE Processing, section 2
 - Provides more detail to the overall electronic data exchange (EDE) processing
 - Step by step instructions for doing the different process
 - How to make a duplicate request
 - How to add your school code to a student's record



Structure of EDE Tech Ref (Cont.)

- Record Layouts, section 3
 - The Record Layout section is a map to read the data sent by the CPS, or a map of what the CPS is expecting to receive
 - EDEExpress has the record layout logic written into the program

Structure of EDE Tech Ref (Cont.)

- Record Layouts, section 3 (Cont.)
 - New layout HOLD02OP; file of all student's applications who listed your school that are on hold at CPS waiting for appropriate signatures
 - Demographic info
 - Date added to Hold file
 - Electronic App Entry Source
 - Signed By
 - Model

Structure of EDE Tech Ref (Cont.)

- Processing Codes/System Requirements, section 4
 - 2000-2001 to 2001-2002 ISIR Cross-Reference
 - Table of Reject Codes and How to Respond to Each
 - Deleted Reject 20
 - 14 - Missing student signature
 - A - Date of birth year equals 1900, 1901 or 1902
 - C - Taxes paid equal Adjusted Gross Income



Structure of EDE Tech Ref (Cont.)

- Processing Codes/System Requirements, section 4 (Cont.)
 - Error Messages with code and text
 - Assumption Overrides
 - Comment Codes
 - SAR/ISIR Correction Flags and Correction/Highlight Field Number



Structure of EDE Tech Ref (Cont.)

- Processing Codes/System Requirements, section 4 (Cont.)
 - NSLDS Codes
 - State/Country/Jurisdiction Codes
 - Correction Data Entry Specifications



Structure of EDE Tech Ref (Cont.)

- Printing, section 5
 - Layouts for printing ISIRs and Renewal Applications to ED specifications
 - Describes assumptions, highlights, comments, signed-numeric values, rejects and how to print them
 - Sample output documents



Changes to the Printed ISIR

■ ISIR Page 1

- Changed year reference on each page
- Page number moved from top to bottom
- Trankey prints

Changes to the Printed ISIR (Cont.)

■ ISIR Page 2

– Examples of Label changes

- Enrollment plans
- Legal Residence Date
- Grade Level in College
- Father's/Stepfather's SSN
- Adjusted Gross Income
- Total from Worksheet A
- Total from Worksheet B



Changes to the Printed ISIR (Cont.)

■ ISIR Page 2 (Cont.)

– Examples of Print Instruction changes

- Driver's License #
- Marital Status
- Enrollment Plans
- Father's Educational Level
- Grade Level in College
- Tax Return Filed
- Eligible to File 1040A or 1040 EZ

– Deleted

- Have Driver's License?
- Net Worth of Investment Farm
- Earned Income Credit for Student and Parent's

– Added

- E-mail Address
- Have Children You Support?
- Total from Worksheet C for Student and Parent's



Changes to the Printed ISIR (Cont.)

- ISIR Page 2 (Cont.)
 - Step labels changed
 - Drug Conv Affecting Elig? renamed and moved
 - Cash, Savings and Checking moved
 - Added @ description in footer

Changes to the Printed ISIR (Cont.)

■ ISIR Page 3

– Label changes

- School #
- Housing #
- Federal School Code Indicator
- Paid EFC Type



Changes to the Printed ISIR (Cont.)

- ISIR Page 3 (Cont.)
 - Print Instruction changes
 - Signed By
 - Application Source
 - Dependency Override
 - FAA Adjustment



Changes to the Printed ISIR (Cont.)

■ ISIR Page 3 (Cont.)

- Added
 - Duplicate SSN Flag
 - INS Sec. Conf. Flag
- Switched Application Receipt Date and Transaction Receipt Date locations
- Added @ description in footer



Changes to the Printed ISIR (Cont.)

- ISIR Page 4
 - Text changed to reflect certification page changes

Changes to the Printed ISIR NSLDS Page

- NSLDS Page 1 and 2
 - Added title across top of page 2001-2002
Institutional Student Information Record
 - Changed year references
 - Changed format of Processed date from
MM-DD-CCYY to MM/DD/CCYY



Changes to the Printed ISIR NSLDS Page (Cont.)

- NSLDS Page 1 and 2 (Cont.)
 - Increased field length for Pell EFC
 - Scheduled Amount
 - Award Amount
 - Amount Paid
 - Remaining Amount Paid :



Changes to the Printed ISIR NSLDS Page (Cont.)

■ NSLDS Page 1

– Label Changes

- Subsidized Loans:
- Pell Verification Flag

– Added Fields

- Extra Unsub
- Capitalized Interest



Changes to the Printed ISIR NSLDS Page (Cont.)

■ NSLDS Page 1 (Cont.)

– Print Instruction Changes

- Overpayment values of D and W added for:
 - NSLDS Pell Overpayment Flag
 - NSLDS SEOG Overpayment Flag
 - NSLDS Perkins Overpayment Flag



Changes to the Printed ISIR NSLDS Page (Cont.)

■ NSLDS Page 2

- Added a line of asterisks
- Added page number at bottom of page
- Added Fields
 - Extra Unsub
 - Capitalized Interest
 - MPN Information
 - Direct Loan MPN:
 - FFEL MPN
 - FFEL MPN Lender Code



Structure of EDE Tech Ref (Cont.)

- Miscellaneous, section 6
 - Provides additional information necessary to assist user in the EDE implementation process
 - Message Classes
 - Optional testing procedures with test cases
 - Removed the ISIR change list
- Index



As You Requested!

- More space for first name and street
 - i.e. Christopher and foreign addresses
- Modified values
 - Grade Level
 - Tax Return Filing Status
 - Eligible to File 1040A or 1040EZ



As You Requested! (Cont.)

- Correction flags
- Master Promissory Note (MPN) flags for DL and FFEL
- State agencies will get NSLDS info on ISIR



Message Classes

- Year increased from 01 to 02
- New HOLD02OP
- Modified Correction ISIR and Correction Error file names
 - Instead of,
 - SARR02OP -- changed to CORR02OP
 - SARE02OP -- changed to CORE02OP



Message Classes (Cont.)

- Modified resident and non-resident state agency ISIR file names
 - Resident ISIRs
Instead of YTDN02OP -- YTDR02OP
 - Non-resident ISIRs
Instead of YTDF02OP -- YTDN02OP
